



Submission Terms and Conditions

Thank you for participating in the Aspen Institute's Youth and Engagement programming and for submitting content for consideration for publication on aspeninstitute.org/youth. The Aspen Institute (the "Institute") will use the term "content" to mean and refer to any and all written, visual, video or audio materials you submit. By submitting content to the Aspen Institute, you signify your agreement to and acceptance of all Content Submission Guidelines and the following terms and conditions:

You certify that at the time of your submission you are at least 13 years of age. If you are under the age of 18 but at least 13 years of age, you may submit content only with the permission of, and under the supervision of, a parent or legal guardian. If you are a parent or legal guardian agreeing to these Terms and Conditions for the benefit of an individual between the ages of 13 and 18, please be advised that you are fully responsible for his or her submissions and any legal liability that he or she may incur.

You certify that your submission is wholly original and created by you.

You certify that your submission does not infringe any rights of any third party, including, but not limited to, copyright, trademark, privacy and publicity rights, or violate any law or regulation. You must not include materials, images, graphics, music, trademarks, logos or brand names belonging to any third parties that has not been authorized by such party.

You certify that you have the permission of others who have contributed to or are featured in any content you submit. If there are any individuals under the age of 18 in any photos, video, or other content that you submit, you must obtain the permission of each such individual's parent or legal guardian prior to submitting the content.

For any content that you submit, you give the Institute permission to use such content. You retain ownership in your content, but by making a submission you grant to the Institute, and those authorized by the Institute, a irrevocable, perpetual, worldwide, exclusive license to disseminate, modify, and use your content, in whole or in part, in all media now known or later developed. You understand that your permission for the Institute to use the content in your submission is for an unlimited duration and that you will not receive any compensation for granting this permission or for the use of content, if any, by the Institute.

You are solely and entirely responsible for all content that you submit and the consequences of their submission. You are liable for any injury or damages caused or claimed to be caused by your content, and you agree to indemnify, release and hold harmless the Institute, and its directors, officers, employees, and agents from any third party claim for liabilities, losses, claims, suits, damages, costs and expenses (including without limitation, reasonable attorneys' fees) injuries or causes of action whatsoever that in any way are caused by, arise out of or result from, your creation and submission of content, on any legal theory whatsoever, including without limitation, claims for copyright, invasion of privacy and defamation.

Content Submission Guidelines and these Terms and Conditions By making a submission, you waive any privacy expectations you may have with regard to your content. If the Institute selects your submission for inclusion on its website and social media channels, the Institute will make the submission, in whole or part, available to the general public.

If selected for inclusion on the Institute's website, you understand that a signed Media Release must be received by the Institute as a condition of publication. If you are a parent or legal guardian agreeing to these Terms and Conditions for the benefit of an individual between the ages of 13 and 18, please be advised that you also must sign and submit a Media Release.

These Terms and Conditions shall be governed by the laws of the District of Columbia. You agree that any controversy, claim or dispute of whatever nature arising between the parties shall be resolved exclusively through binding arbitration in Washington, DC before a single arbitrator, pursuant to the American Arbitration Association's then-in-effect National Rules for the Resolution of Commercial Disputes

These Terms and Conditions represent the entire agreement between you and the Institute. They can be changed only by another written agreement, and cannot be orally modified.
